Safety Lead

About the role

The Safety Lead is responsible for ensuring all aspects of the event are delivered safely. This includes reviewing and adapting policies, overseeing the main event risk assessment, and working with Event Leads to review and sign off activity and zone risk assessments.

Key Responsibilities

- Review and update event safety policies and procedures.
- Create and manage the main event risk assessment.
- Support Zone Leads with activity risk assessments and sign-off.
- Work with the Event Leads to ensure safety is prioritised across all planning and delivery.

Person Criteria

- Applicants must be 18+
- Must be available for the event on Saturday 9th May 2026
- Must be available for the event set up on Friday 8th May 2026.

Training Requirements

This role requires the Scouts Getting Started Training to be completed within 5 months of your role start date. These are a few short online modules which cover things such as Safety and Safeguarding. If you are already involved in Scouts, it's likely you'll have already done these and generally won't be required to do them specifically for this role.

Time Commitment

Outside of the event there will be a number of meetings with the team across the year, these tend to be monthly mixed between in person (Basingstoke) and hybrid. Most other aspects of the role can be done as suits the role holder.
