Under 18 Rep

About the role

The Under 18 Rep represents the interests and needs of attendees under the age of 18 of their own organisation (Basingstoke East Scouts, Basingstoke West Scouts or Girlguiding). This person ensures that activities and event logistics are appropriate and engaging for younger participants.

Key Responsibilities

- Advocate for the needs and interests of under-18 attendees.
- Provide input on activities and programmes suitable for younger participants.
- Coordinate with other leads to ensure under-18 inclusivity.
- Gather feedback from under-18 attendees to improve future events.

Person Criteria

- Applicants must be under the age of 18
- Must be available for the event on Saturday 9th May 2026

Training Requirements

Due to being under the age of 18 - there are no formal training but we'd recommend going through the Safety and Safeguarding online modules so you're aware of the training which other adults have been through.

Time Commitment

Outside of the event there will be a number of meetings with the team across the year, these tend to be monthly mixed between in person (Basingstoke) and hybrid. Most other aspects of the role can be done as suits the role holder.
