# Deputy Event Lead

## About the role

The Deputy Event Lead supports the Event Leads in the planning, coordination, and delivery of the event. Acting as a deputy to the Event Leads, they help oversee all aspects of event preparation and delivery, provide leadership to the wider event team, and support incident management and decision-making during the event.

## Key Responsibilities

- Support the Event Leads with the planning, coordination, and delivery of the event.
- Act as a deputy for the Event Leads, representing them when required.
- Assist with the coordination of Event Leads and delivery teams to ensure plans remain on track.
- Support the monitoring of event progress and help resolve issues as they arise.
- Assist with incident management and operational decision-making during the event.
- Help ensure event policies, procedures, and standards are implemented effectively.
- Support communication and coordination between teams before, during, and after the event.
- Contribute to event reviews and lessons learned following the event.

## Person Criteria

- Applicants must be 18+
- Must be available for the event on Saturday 8th May 2027
- Must be available for the event set up on Friday 7th May 2027

## **Training Requirements**

This role requires the Scouts Getting Started Training to be completed within 5 months of your role start date. These are a few short online modules which cover things such as Safety and Safeguarding. If you are already involved in Scouts, it's likely you'll have already done these and generally won't be required to do them specifically for this role.

## **Time Commitment**

Outside of the event there will be a number of meetings with the team across the year, these tend to be monthly mixed between in person (Basingstoke) and hybrid. Most other aspects of the role can be done as suits the role holder.
